








# Warnings









---

To reduce the risk of serious injury, read the entire manual before you assemble or use this Slide. In particular, please note the following safety precautions. Please keep this manual in a safe place for future reference.

1. Prior to assembly, this Slide includes small parts/accessories that are not suitable for children under 3 years of age as they may cause a choking hazard.
2. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that all users of this Slide are adequately informed of all warnings and precautions. This Slide is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities; or lack of experience and knowledge unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the Slide by a person responsible for their safety.
3. This Slide should be assembled by 2 adults.
4. Place this Slide on a soft level surface with at least 2.5m diameter of clear space surrounding the unit.
5. This Slide is suitable for users aged 3 years and over.
6. **This slide has a maximum user weight of 45kg.**
7. Do not allow more than 1 person on the Slide at any time.
8. This slide is designed for domestic use only, it is not intended for commercial use in play centres, nurseries etc
9. Do not use the Slide when wet.
10. Do not use the Slide while under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Balance, perception and assessment of risk will be affected and may lead to injury.
11. Do not allow any activity underneath the Slide.
12. Do not use foreign objects with the Slide, use of any foreign objects will void the warranty.
13. Inspect the Slide before each use, replace any worn or defective parts. If you require replacement parts to be sent out, please contact our National Service Centre (details can be found in the warranty pages at the end of this manual).

Slide chute assembly

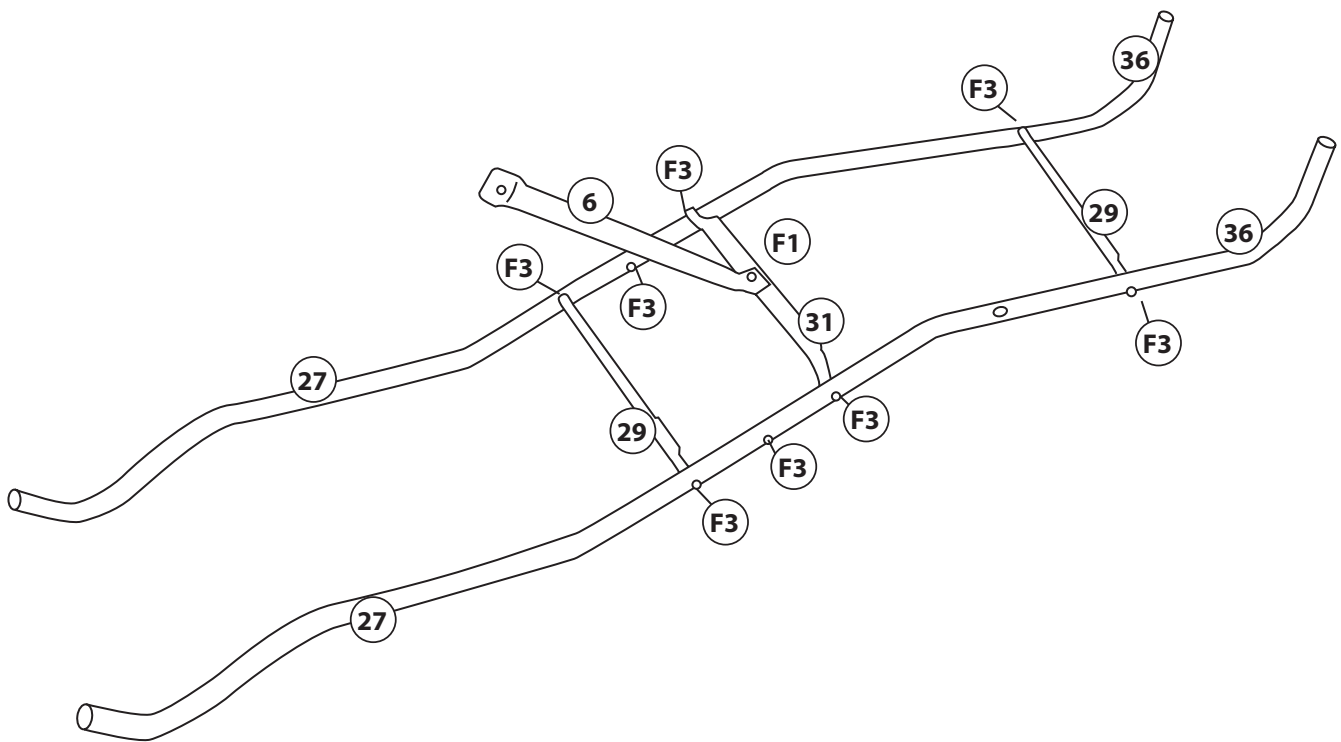
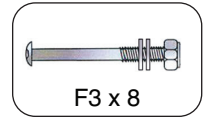
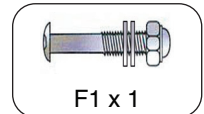

Bracket assembly

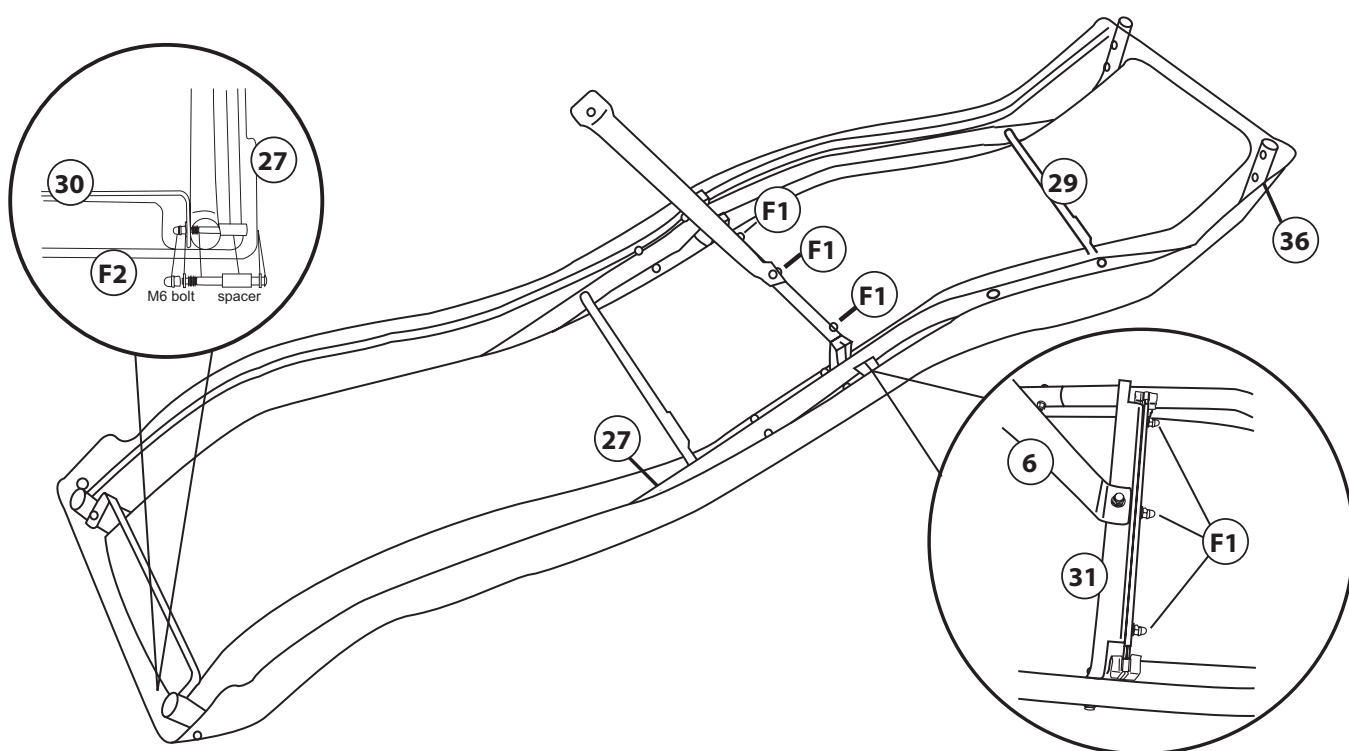
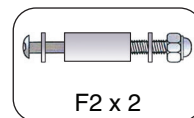
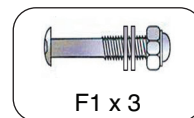
The F3 bolts for part 31 only need to be finger tight

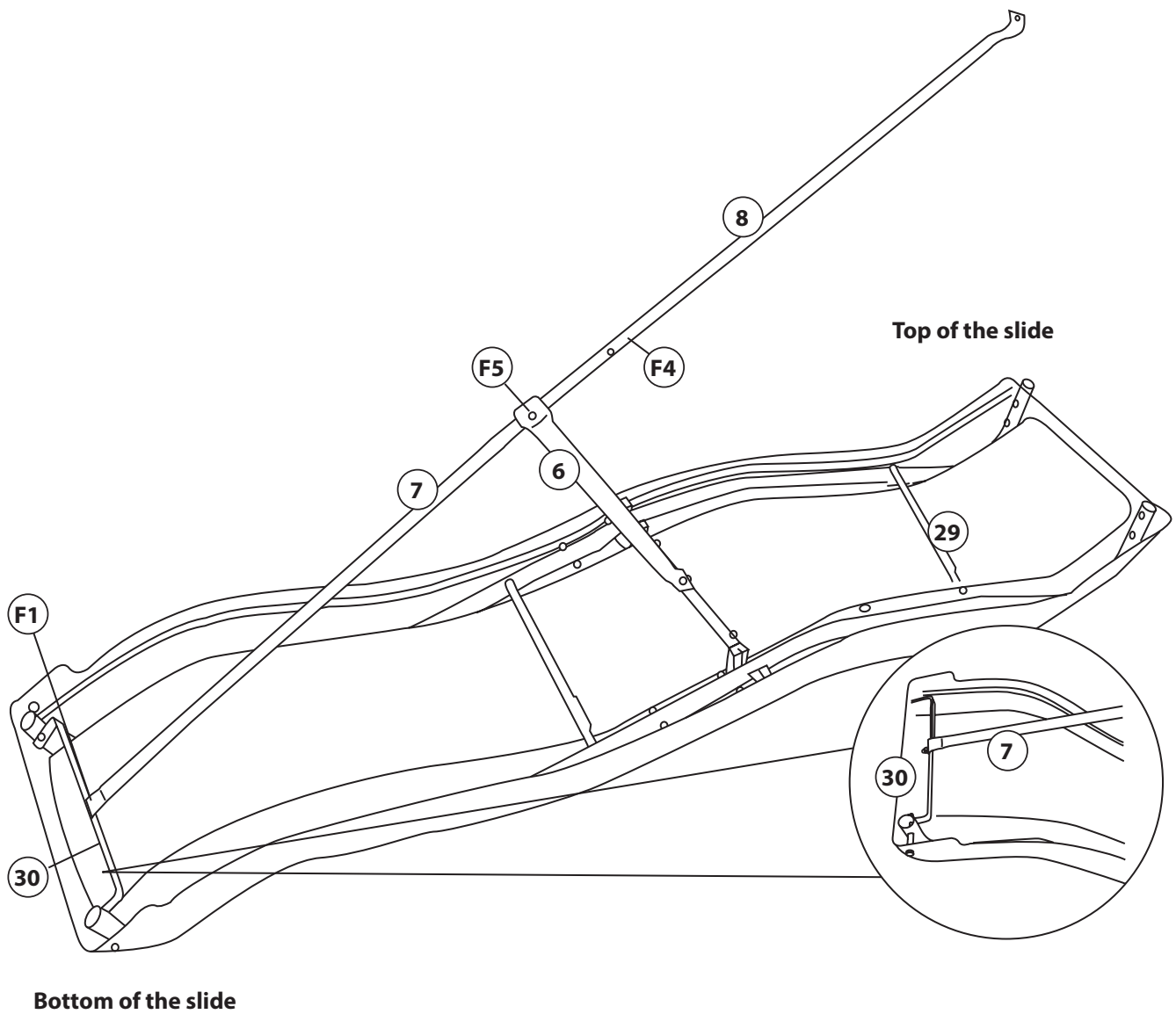
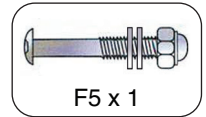
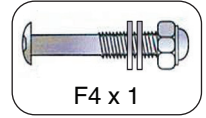
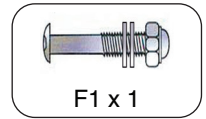
Assembly of the bracket onto the slide

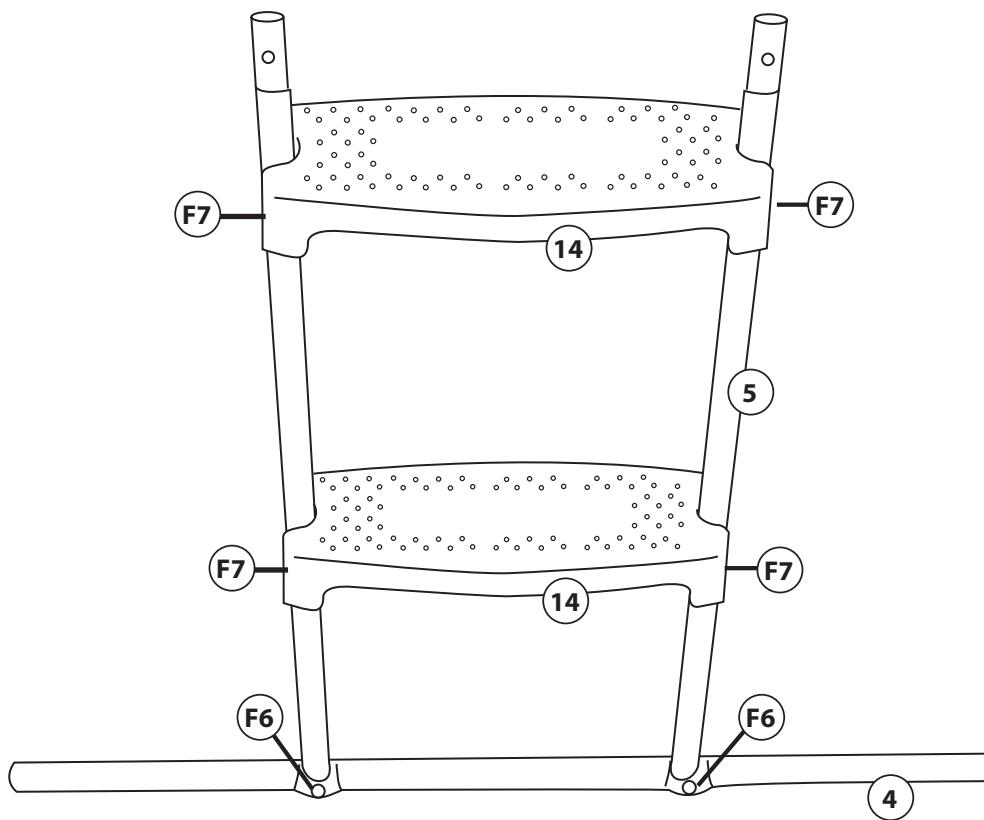
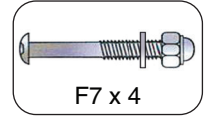
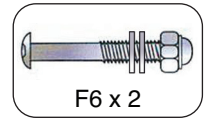
Tie bar assembly

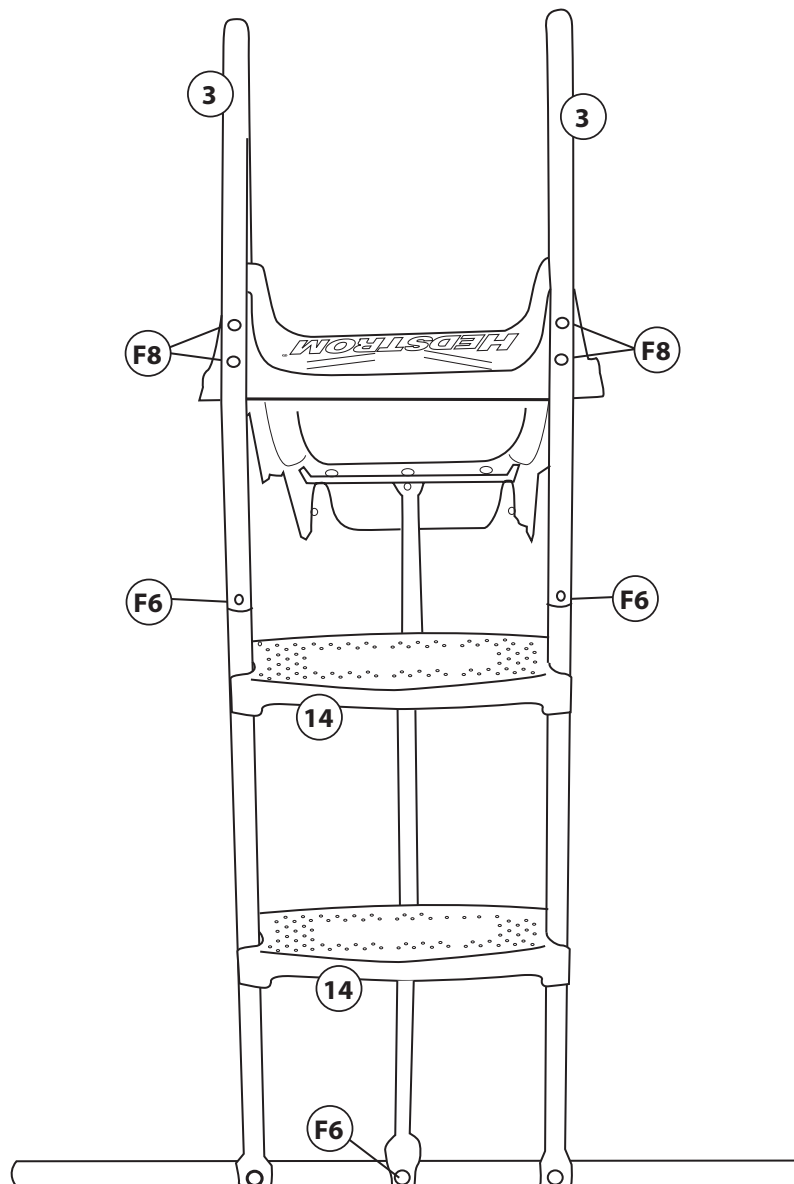
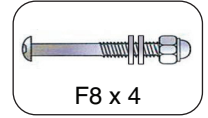
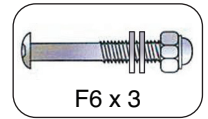
Ladder assembly

Assembling the ladder to the slide



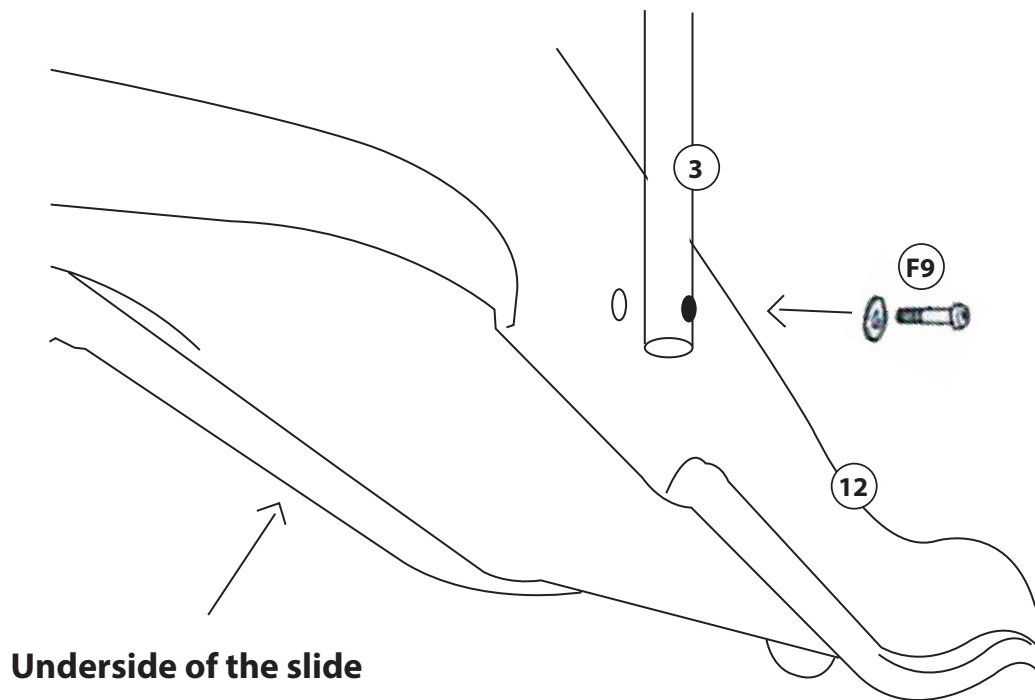
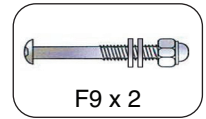

## Making A Warranty Claim

The National Sales and Service Centre representative will assess the claim. If:

- 1) **There is a minor fault**, they can offer either a replacement spare part, replacement unit, repair or other suitable remedy.
- 2) **There is a major fault**, they can offer a replacement, repair or suggest you return to the store you purchased it from for a full refund.

**PLEASE NOTE:** a request for compensation will need documentary evidence of the loss or damage suffered. It will also need to be evidenced that such a loss was a reasonably foreseeable result of a failure to comply with a consumer guarantee under the Australian Consumer Law.

- 3) **The product was damaged through abnormal use**, no refund or repair can be offered.
