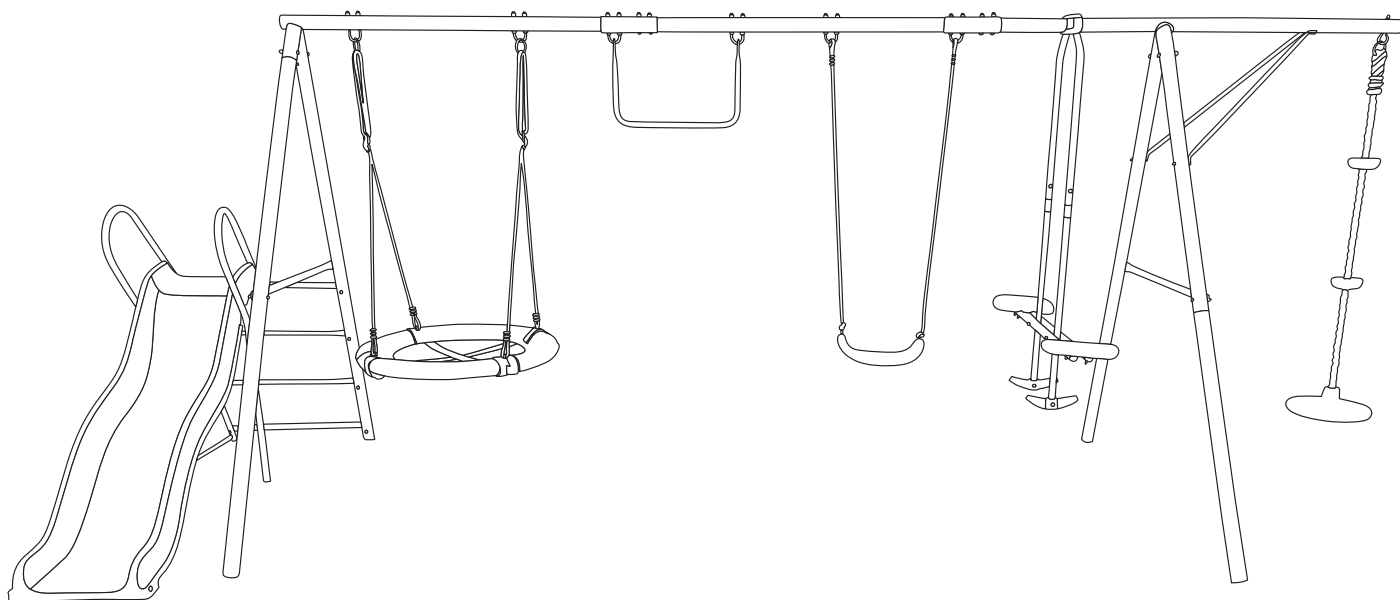

READ PRIOR TO ASSEMBLING AND USING THE SWING SET



WARNING: To ensure everyone's safety, please do not attempt to assemble this swing set without reading this instruction manual carefully. Failure to comply with this warning may result in injury and/or property damage.

- Prior to assembly, this swing set includes small parts/accessories that are not suitable for children under 3 years of age as they may cause a choking hazard.
- This swing set should be assembled by 2 adults.
- Only use this swing set on a soft, flat level surface
- **This swing set has a maximum user weight of 45kg per unit/seat. The total weight on the swing set at any time must not exceed 270kg.**
- **Only one child per seat at any time.**
- This swing set is suitable for children 3-9 years of age.
- This swing set is designed for outdoor domestic use only, it is not intended for commercial use in play centres, nurseries, etc.

Important Safety Information




To reduce the risk of serious injury, read the entire manual before you assemble or use this swing set. In particular, please note the following safety precautions. Please keep this manual in a safe place for future reference. Failure to assemble and maintain this product correctly may cause injury to the user.



1. Prior to assembly, this swing set includes small parts/accessories that are not suitable for children under 3 years of age as they may cause a choking hazard.
2. This swing set should be assembled by 2 adults.
3. This swing set is designed for domestic use only, it is not intended for commercial use in play centres, nurseries, etc.
4. This swing set is designed for use by children 3-9 years of age.
5. This swing set has a maximum user weight of 45kg per seat, totalling 270kg across the entirety of the swing set.
6. Do not install this product over concrete, asphalt or any other hard surface.
7. Do not orientate the swing set directly towards the sun.
8. There should be at least 2m of space surrounding the swing set from any structure of obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, wall, overhanging branches, laundry lines, electrical wires, etc.
9. Regularly check the swing set for wear and damage, replace any worn or damaged parts immediately. Remove the swing set from use until replacement parts are fitted. Check all hardware regularly and tighten when required.
10. Do not overtighten the nuts and bolts. Use hand tools only, do not use power tools as this can weaken the connection points.
11. The minimum distance between any swing and the ground is 35cm.
12. Swings must not exceed an angle of 60° from the ground.
13. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times when the swing set is in use.
14. Only one child should use the swing at any time.
15. Do not stand on the seats when using the swing set.
16. Do not use the swing set when it is wet as it will become slippery and serious injury may result.
17. Do not climb on or jump from the swing set when it is in motion.
18. Do not climb or hang on the frame of the swing set.
19. Do not allow additional foreign objects to be attached or used with the swing set.
20. Do not walk close to, in front of or behind the swing set when in use as moving units can cause serious injury.
21. Do not wear apparel such as hats with straps, helmets, scarves, garments with pull strings or any other item of loose clothing while using the swing set as children can get trapped and may be unable to free themselves causing serious injury.
22. Do not twist swing ropes or wrap them over the top bar.
23. Anchors shall be placed level with or under the ground in order to reduce tripping hazards.
24. The maximum fall height for this overall product is 182cm.
The maximum fall height for the slide is 81cm.

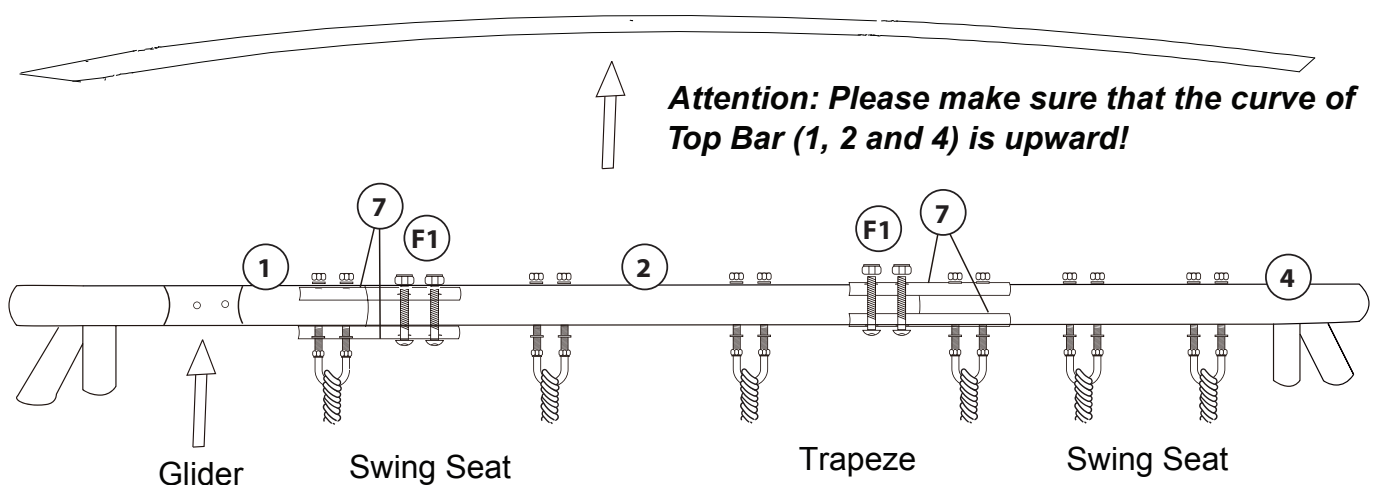
Prior to assembling this swing set, remove all parts from the carton and check to ensure that all parts listed in the Parts List and Hardware List (on pages 4-6) are present. If you're missing any of the parts, please call our National Service Centre to have replacement parts sent out prior to beginning assembly (details can be found in the warranty pages at the end of this manual).

Note: It is recommended that 2 adults assemble this swing set.

Step 1

Align Top Bar A (1), Top Bar B (2) and Top Bar C (4), secure with Brackets (7). Use M8x62mm Bolt (F1) as shown below in image, adding the swing seats and trapeze to the U-bolts before connecting. F1 bolts only secure the centre bar as the U-Bolts for trapeze and swing will secure the rest of the top bar.

Note: Remember to attach the rope/swing bearing to the U-bolts.



Note: Do not fully tighten all the bolts before full assembly.

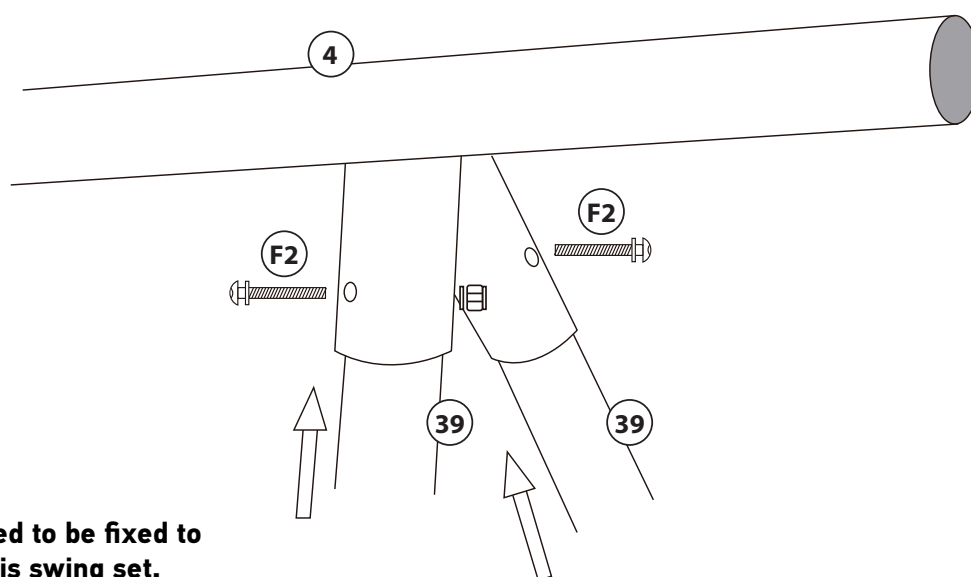
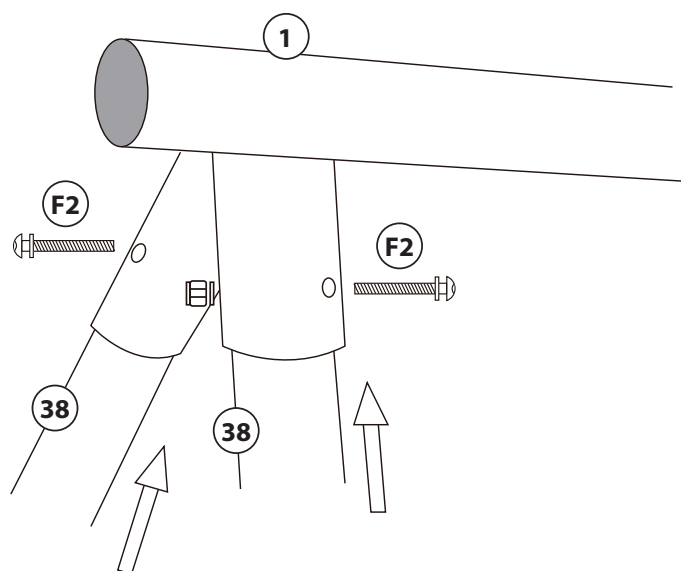
Assembly Instructions (cont.)

Step 2

Insert Top Legs (3) into Top Bar A (1) and secure using M8x53mm Bolts (F2).

Insert Top Legs (3) into Top Bar C (4) and secure using M8x53mm Bolts (F2).

Secure Ball Ring (21) to the end of Top Bar C (4) and secure using M6x14mm Bolts (F10), as shown.



WARNING: BALL RING

This ball ring is not designed to be fixed to any structure other than this swing set. In particular, it must not be fixed to any form of brickwork. Consult a structural engineer if fixing to some structure other than as described in these instructions.

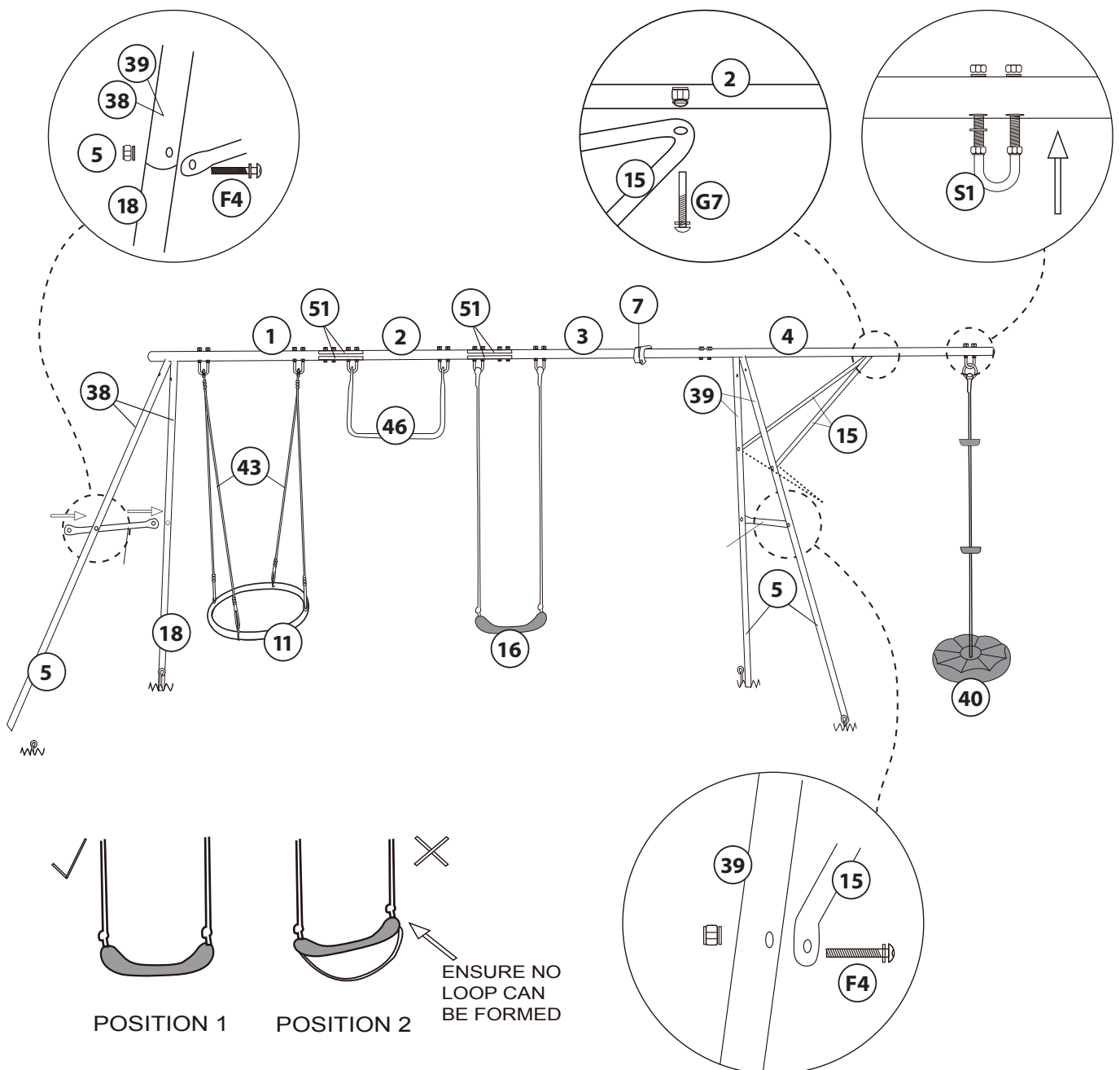
Step 3

Insert Bottom Legs (5) into Top Leg (3), as shown.

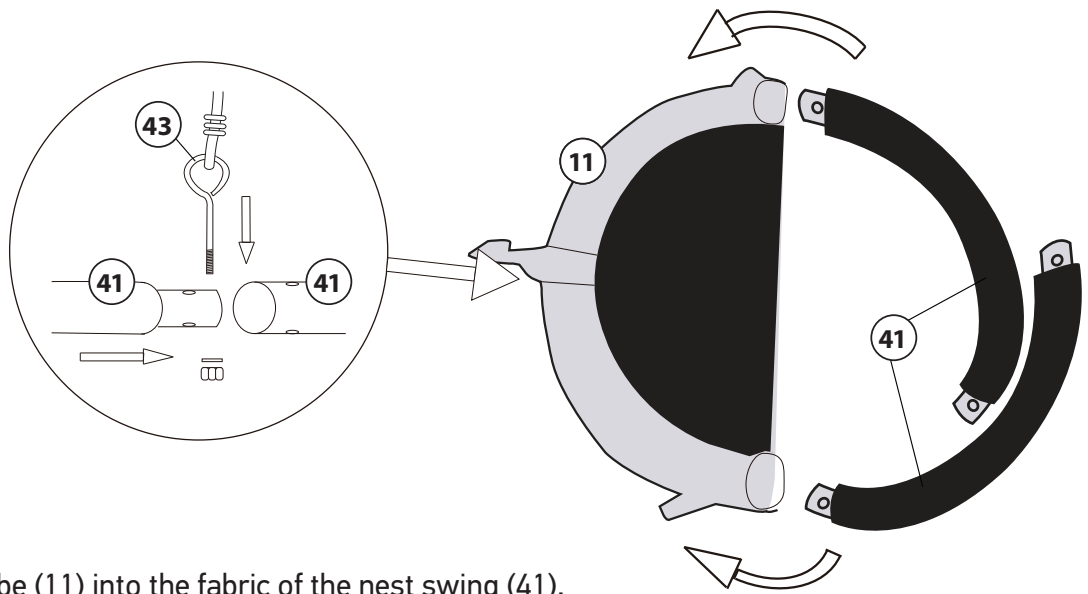
Connect Side Bar A (6) and Side Bar B (18) to connected legs. Secure using M6x52mm Bolts (F5). Please make sure that Side Bar A (6) is assembled at the side of Netball Ring (21). Side Bar B (18) is assembled at opposite end.

Attach Swing Seat (12) using M8 U-bolts x 4 (S1).

Attach Trapeze (14) using M8 U-bolts x 2 (S1).

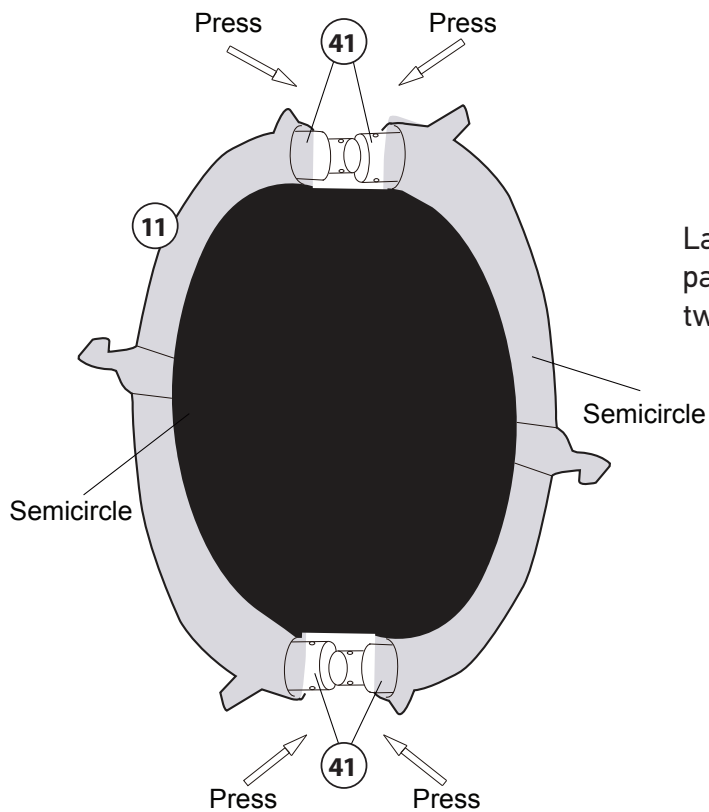
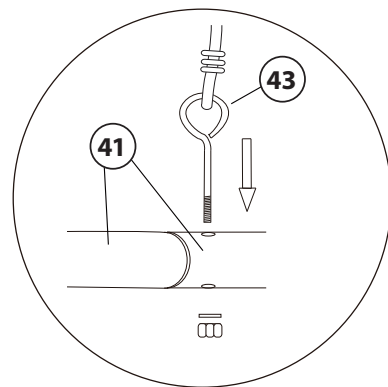


Step 4

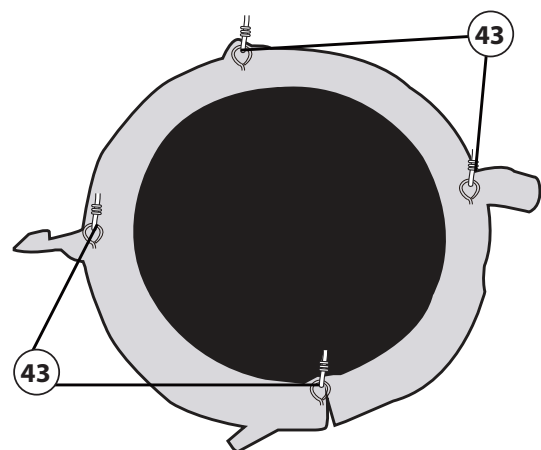
Insert the metal tube (11) into the fabric of the nest swing (41).

Join the metal tubes together and then fasten them by using the bolt at the end of the rope (43). (See Picture 1)

Repeat this for the other side, and then the nest swing becomes two semicircles. (See Picture 2)



Lay the two semicircles on the ground, join the two part tubes together, and then press it down so that two parts are joined together as a circle.

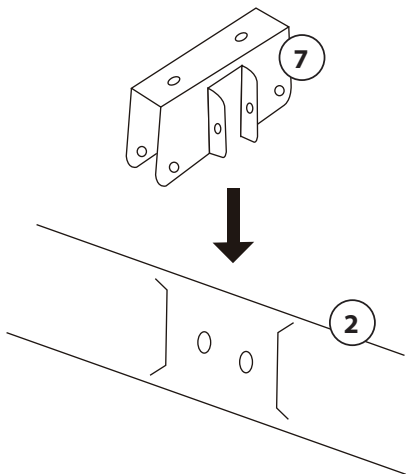

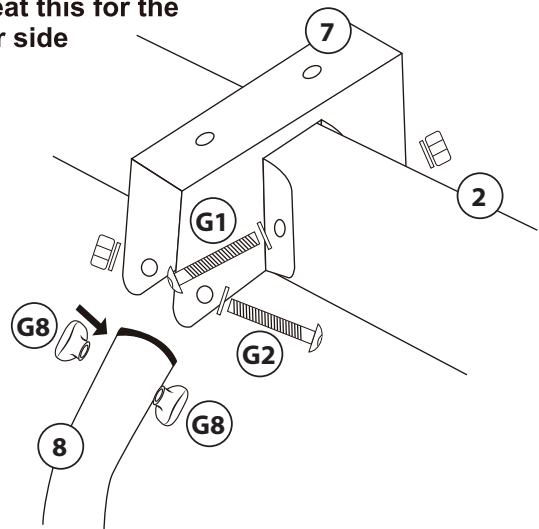
Step 5

Attach the Glider Bracket (16) to Top Bar A (1) and secure using M6x47mm Bolt (G1).

Insert Glider Handle Tube (8) into Glider Bracket (16) and secure using Thin Plastic Spacer (G8) and M8x43mm Bolts (G2).



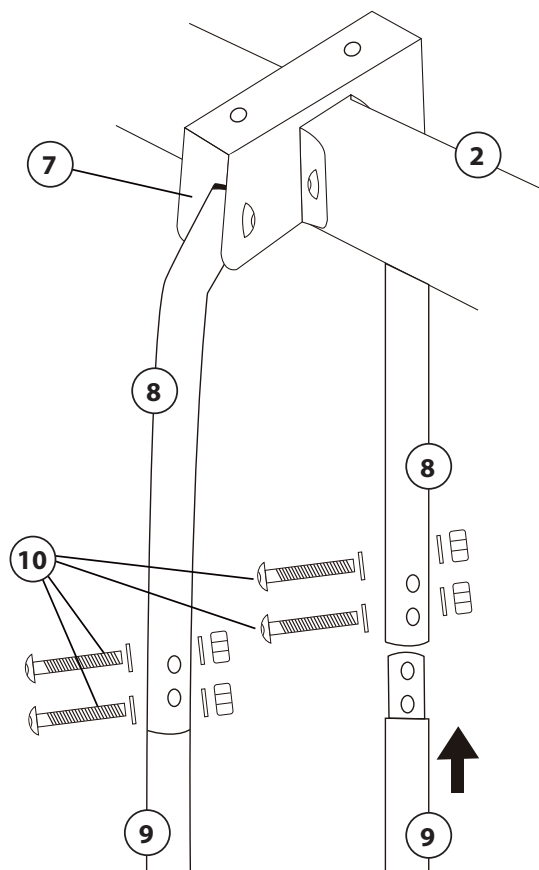
Repeat this for the other side



Step 5

Insert Glider Legs (9) into Glider Handle Tube (8). Secure using M6x35mm Bolts (G6).

Note: Ensure nuts face inwards (see diagram).



Assembly Instructions (cont.)

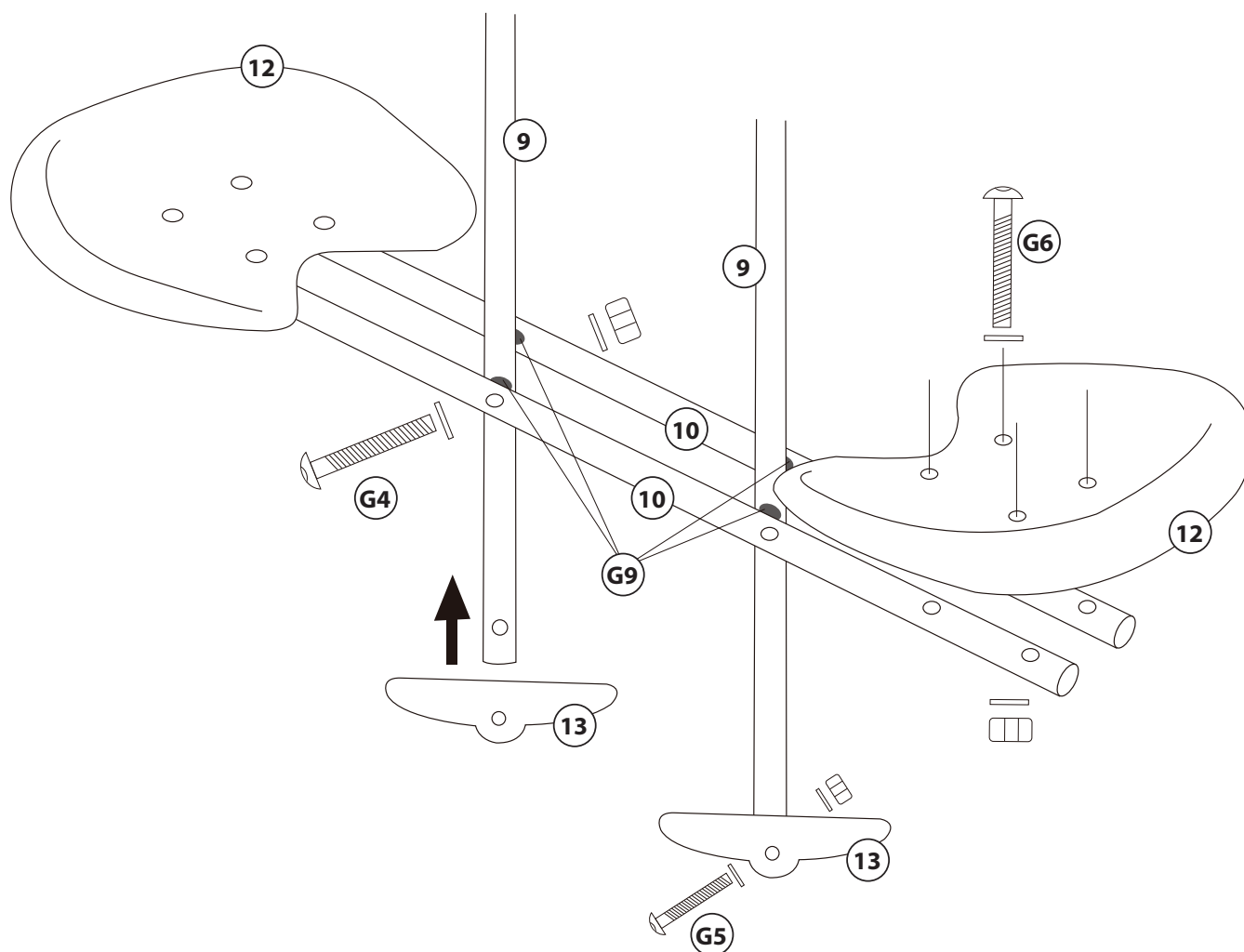
Step 6

Attach Glider Seat Tubes (10) to Glider Legs (9) on either side through Thick Plastic Spacer (G9), ensuring spacers are facing the glider leg pole. Secure using M8x83mm Bolts (G4).

Attach Glider Seats (12) to Glider Seat Tube (10) using M6x38mm Bolts (G6). Ensure the nut is facing down and the bolt is not protruding out, it should sit in the hole or flush to the hole.

Attach Glider Footrests (13) to Glider Legs (9) and secure using M6x47mm Bolts (G5).

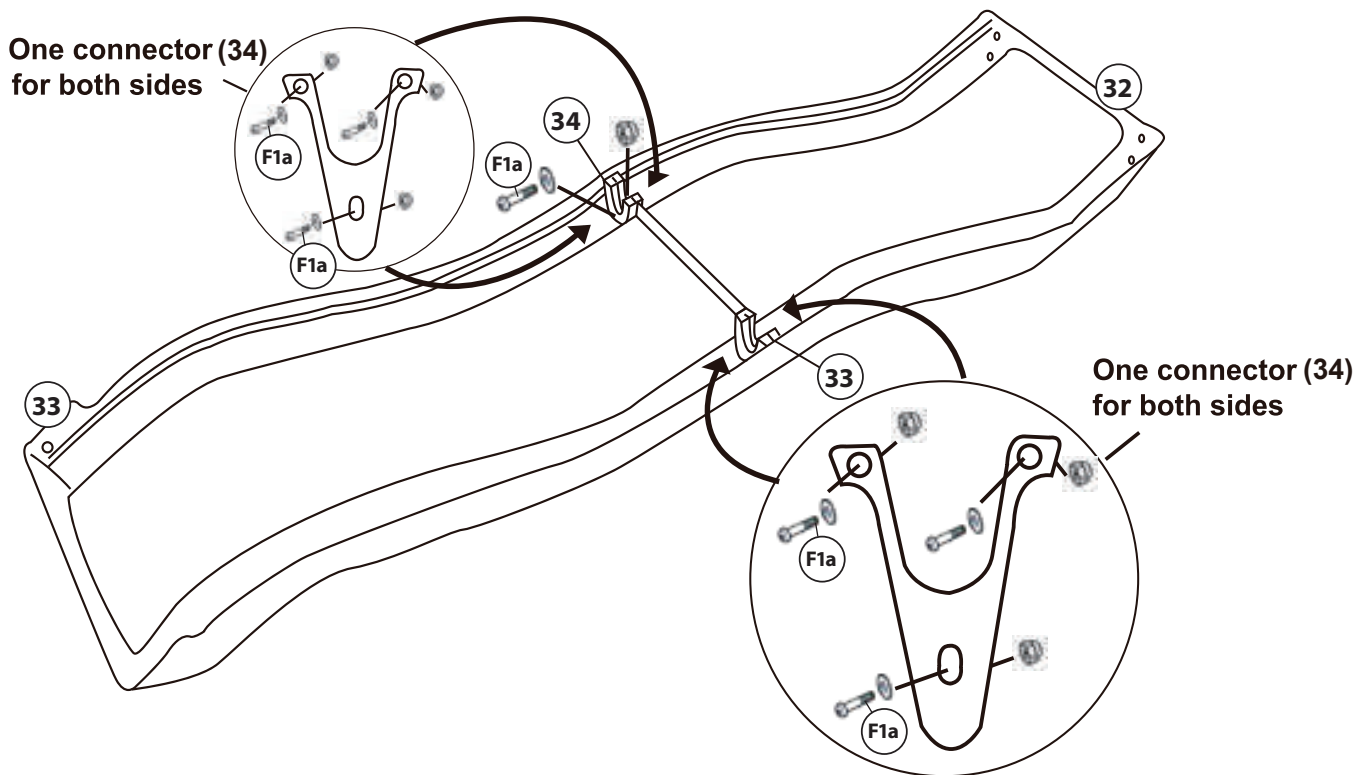
Note: Ensure nuts face inwards for both footrests (see diagram).



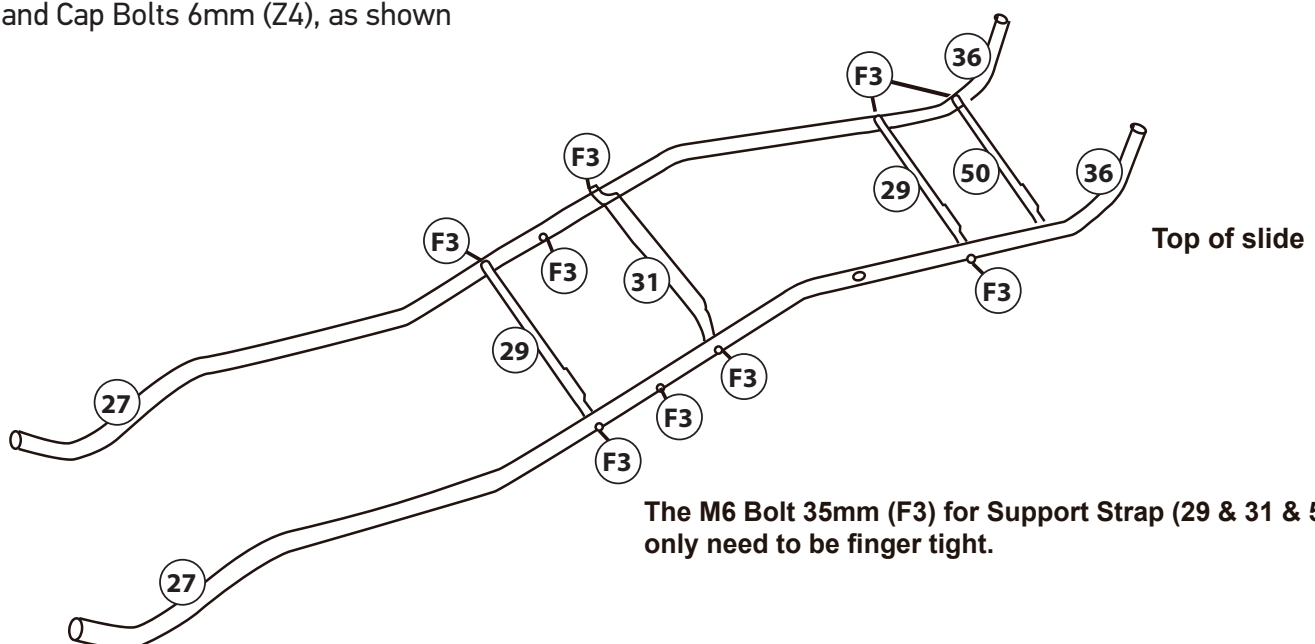
Assembly Instructions (cont.)

Step 7

Push Slide Top Support Bar (X4-N) into receiving location at the top of the Slide (Y2), centering so it's leveled on both sides



Attach Slide Front Support (X5-N) at the base of Slide (Y2).
Secure using 6x58mm Bolts (Z8), Spring Washers small (Z6)
and Cap Bolts 6mm (Z4), as shown

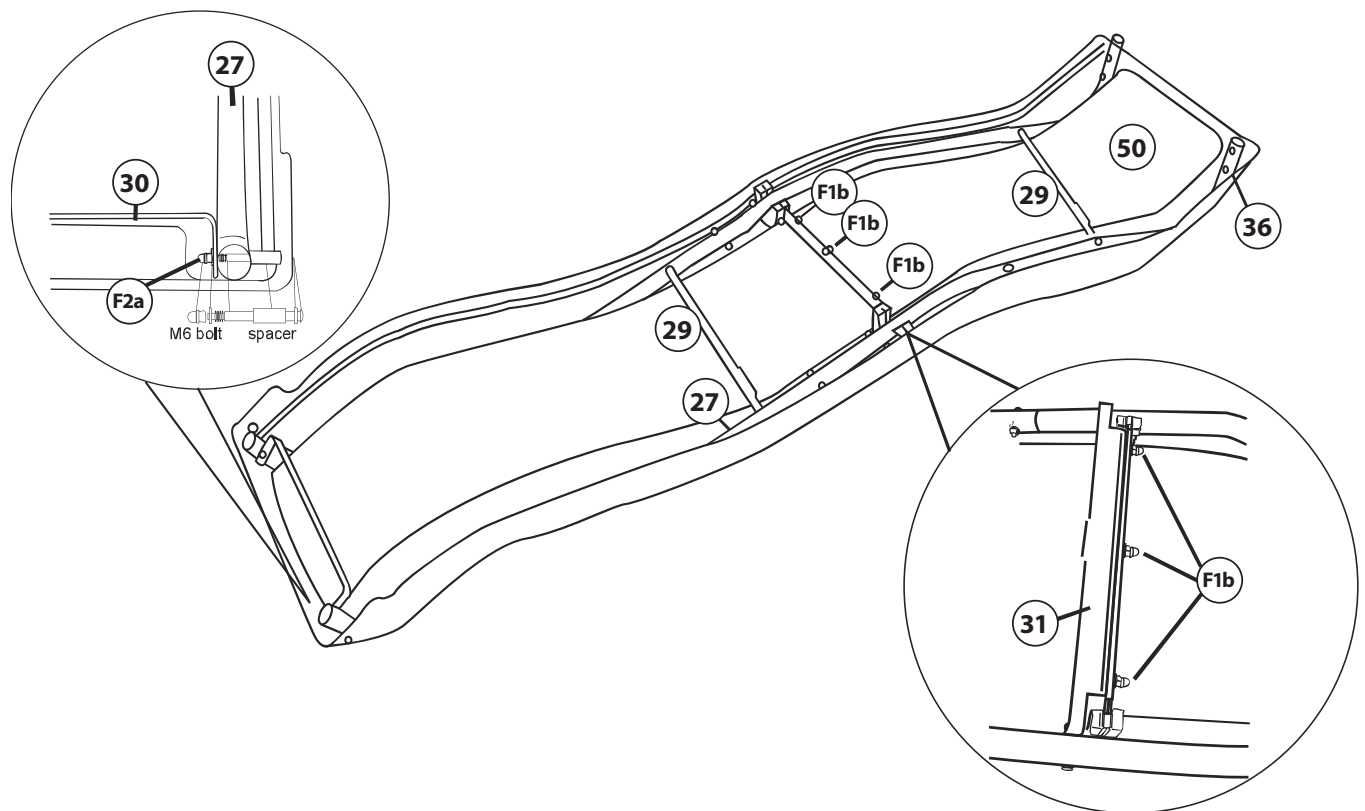


Assembly Instructions (cont.)

Step 8

Fix Slide Support (X1-N) and (X2-N) to Slide Ladder Steps (X6) using 6x34mm Bolts (Z1), Spring Washers small (Z6) and Cap Nuts 6mm (Z4), as shown.

Insert Slide Leg Tubes (X3-N) into Slide Supports (X1-N) and (X2-N).

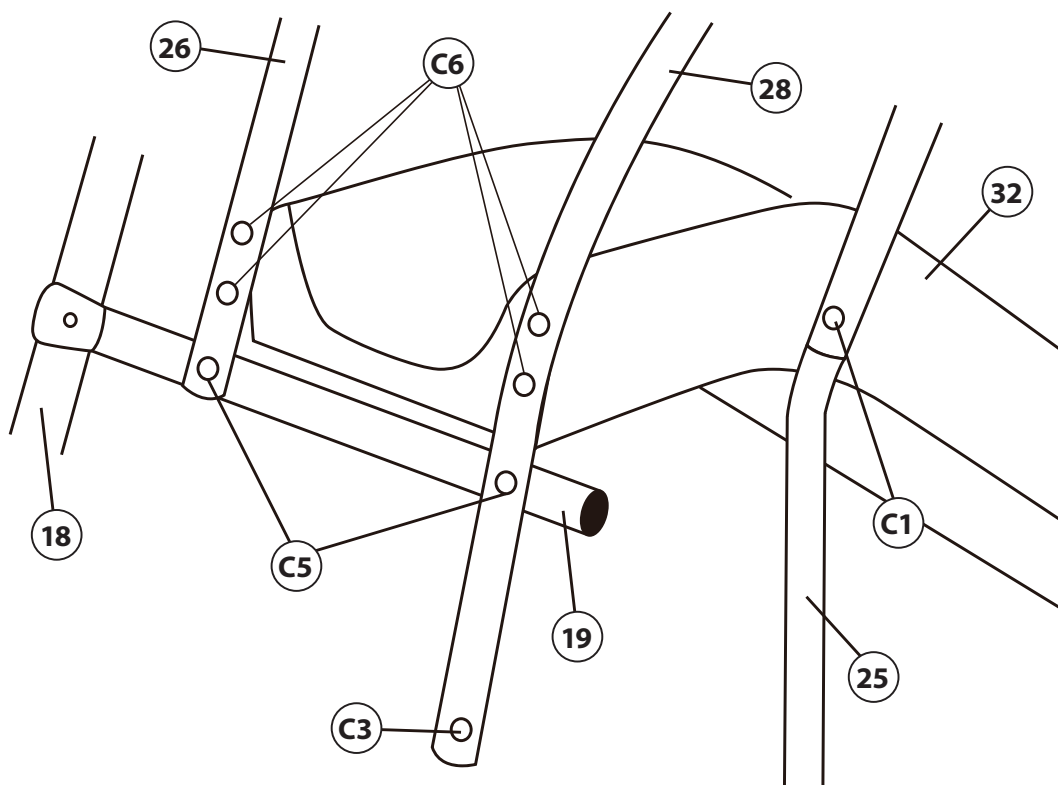


Assembly Instructions (cont.)

Step 9

Connect assembled metal frame to the assembled Slide (Y2).

Secure using 6x38mm Bolts (Z1-1), 6x115mm Bolts (Z2), Spring Washer (large) (Z3), Cap Nut 6mm (Z4), Cap Bolt 6x12mm (Z5) and Spring Washer (small) (Z6), as shown.

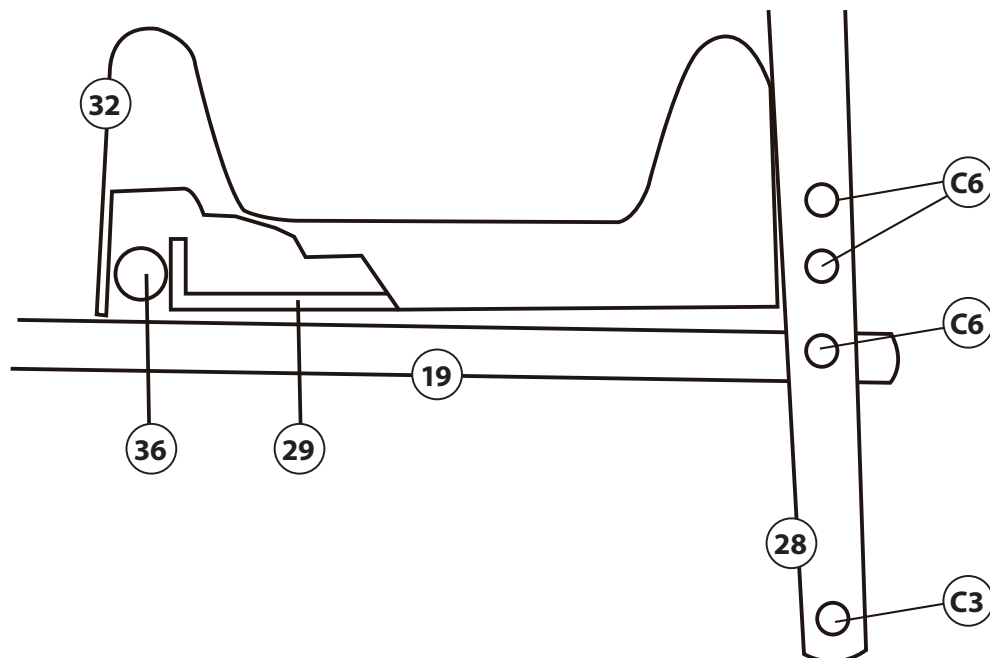


Assembly Instructions (cont.)

Step 11

Using Plastic Connectors (Y1), connect the assembled slide to the main frame Side Bar B (18).

Secure using Spring Washers large (Z3), Cap Bolts 6x12mm (Z5), Spring Washers small (Z6) and 6x76mm Bolts (Z7), as shown.

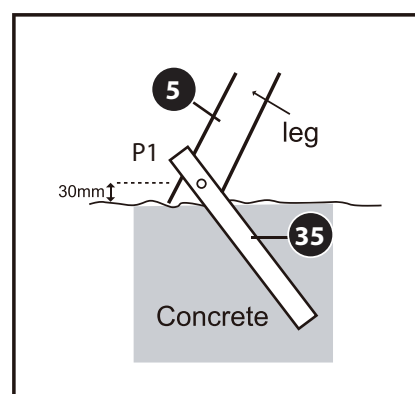
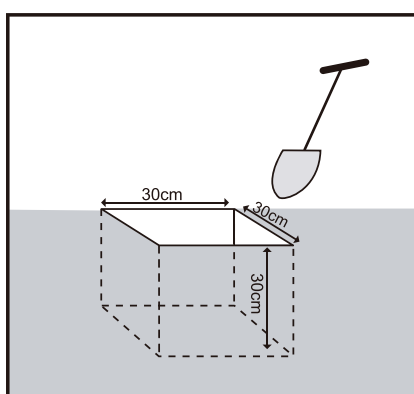
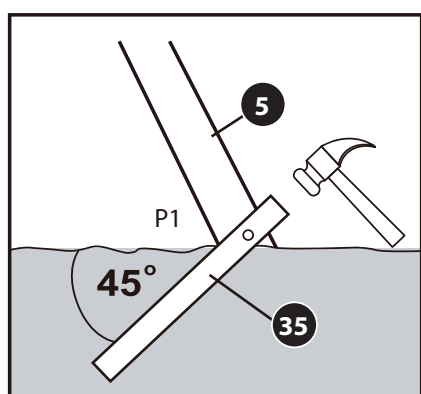

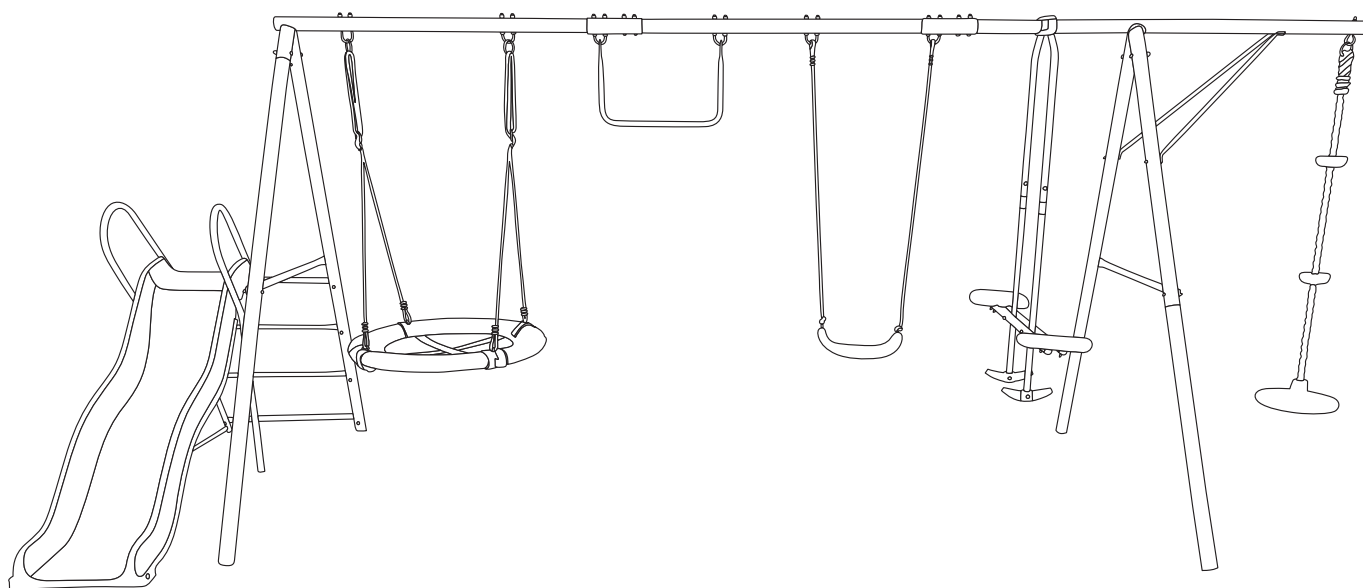
Step 11

Warning: For safety reasons this swing set MUST be anchored into the ground. To carry out this procedure you must hammer the included Ground Pegs into the ground at the angle shown in the picture above. The Ground Pegs must pull into hard earth and hold firmly. We highly recommend that the Ground Pegs be concreted but this is optional. However, if the ground is soft and the Ground Pegs can easily be pulled out by hand once installed then concreting is essential. Contact our Service Centre for more information if you are unsure regarding the installation of the Ground Pegs.

Anchors shall be placed level with or under the ground in order to reduce tripping hazards.



Once assembly is completed, carefully check equipment. In the unlikely event that you do find any problems, please contact us. DO NOT allow children to use this product until the problem has been corrected.



Product Safety Checks And Maintenance

Carry out checks and maintenance of the main parts at regular intervals. If these checks are not carried out, the toy could overturn or otherwise become a hazard.

Check the sharp edges of all protective covers and bolts, and replace them if necessary.

Check anchors are in place, and level with or under the ground to reduce tripping hazards.

Polish rusty areas and tubular parts and repaint them with lead-free paint if necessary.

Warranty Information

This **Spin N Slide Swing Set** is warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service conditions for a period of **12 months**, from the date of purchase of this article. Evidence of unfair usage or incorrect adjustment by the owner will void this promise.
