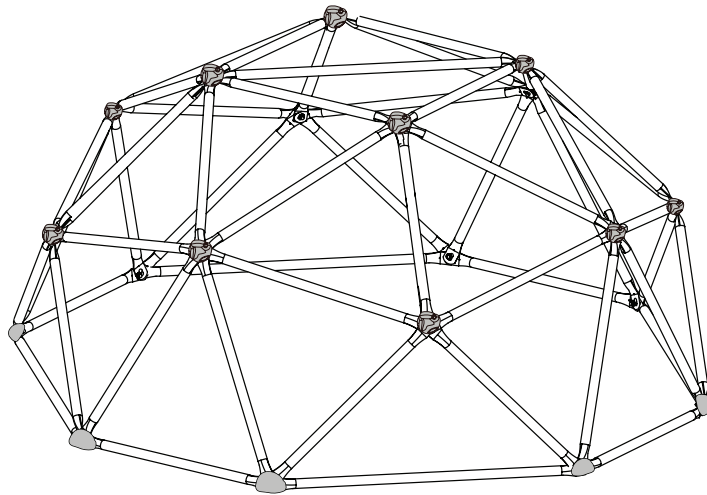

READ PRIOR TO ASSEMBLING AND USING THE CLIMBING DOME



**WARNING:** To ensure everyone's safety, please do not attempt to assemble this climbing dome without reading this instruction manual carefully. Failure to comply with this warning may result in injury and/or property damage.

- Prior to assembly, this climbing dome includes small parts/accessories that are not suitable for children under 3 years of age as they may cause a choking hazard.
- This climbing dome should be assembled by 2 adults.
- The climbing dome should be installed on a soft surface, such as lawn or woodchips. Never use the climbing dome on or over hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt
- The climbing dome should be installed with a safe space of 2 metres around all of the structure. do not install near other backyard installations such as fences, pools, or other play equipment. Never use the climbing dome in conjunction with other play equipment, or attach any other items to the climbing dome.
- Use always under constant adult supervision, with no more than 3 children on the play structure at any one time.
- **This climbing dome is designed for use by children 3-9 years of age weighing no more than 45kg per child, total 135kg.**
- This climbing dome is designed for outdoor domestic use only, it is not intended for commercial use in play centres, nurseries etc.






# Important Safety Information






To reduce the risk of serious injury, read the entire manual before you assemble or use this climbing dome. In particular, please note the following safety precautions. Failure to assemble and maintain this product correctly may cause injury to the user.

1. Prior to assembly, this climbing dome includes small parts/accessories that are not suitable for children under 3 years of age as they may cause a choking hazard.
2. This climbing dome is designed for domestic use only, it is not intended for commercial use in play centres, nurseries, etc.
- 3. This Active Climber is designed for use by children 3-9 years of age weighing no more than 45kg per child, total 135kg.**
4. Use always under constant adult supervision, with no more than 3 children on the play structure at any one time.
5. Place the climbing dome on a level surface before use. Do not install this product over concrete, asphalt or any other hard surface.
6. The climbing dome should be installed with a safe space of 2 metres around all of the structure. do not install near other backyard installations such as fences, pools, or other play equipment. Never use the climbing dome in conjunction with other play equipment, or attach any other items to the climbing dome.
7. Regularly check the climbing dome for wear and damage, replace any worn or damaged parts immediately. Remove the climbing dome from use until replacement parts are fitted. Check all hardware regularly and tighten when required.
8. Do not overtighten the nuts and bolts. Use hand tools only, do not use power tools as this can weaken the connection points.
9. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times when the climbing dome is in use.
10. Do not use the climbing dome when it is wet as it will become slippery and serious injury may result.
11. Do not climb on or jump from the climbing dome.
12. Do not allow additional foreign objects to be attached or used with the climbing dome.
13. Do not wear apparel such as hats with straps, helmets, scarves, garments with pull strings or any other item of loose clothing while using the climbing dome as children can get trapped and may be unable to free themselves causing serious injury.
14. The maximum fall height for this product is 90cm.
15. Retain the assembly and installation instructions for future reference.
16. Anchors should be placed level with or under the ground in order to reduce tripping hazards.

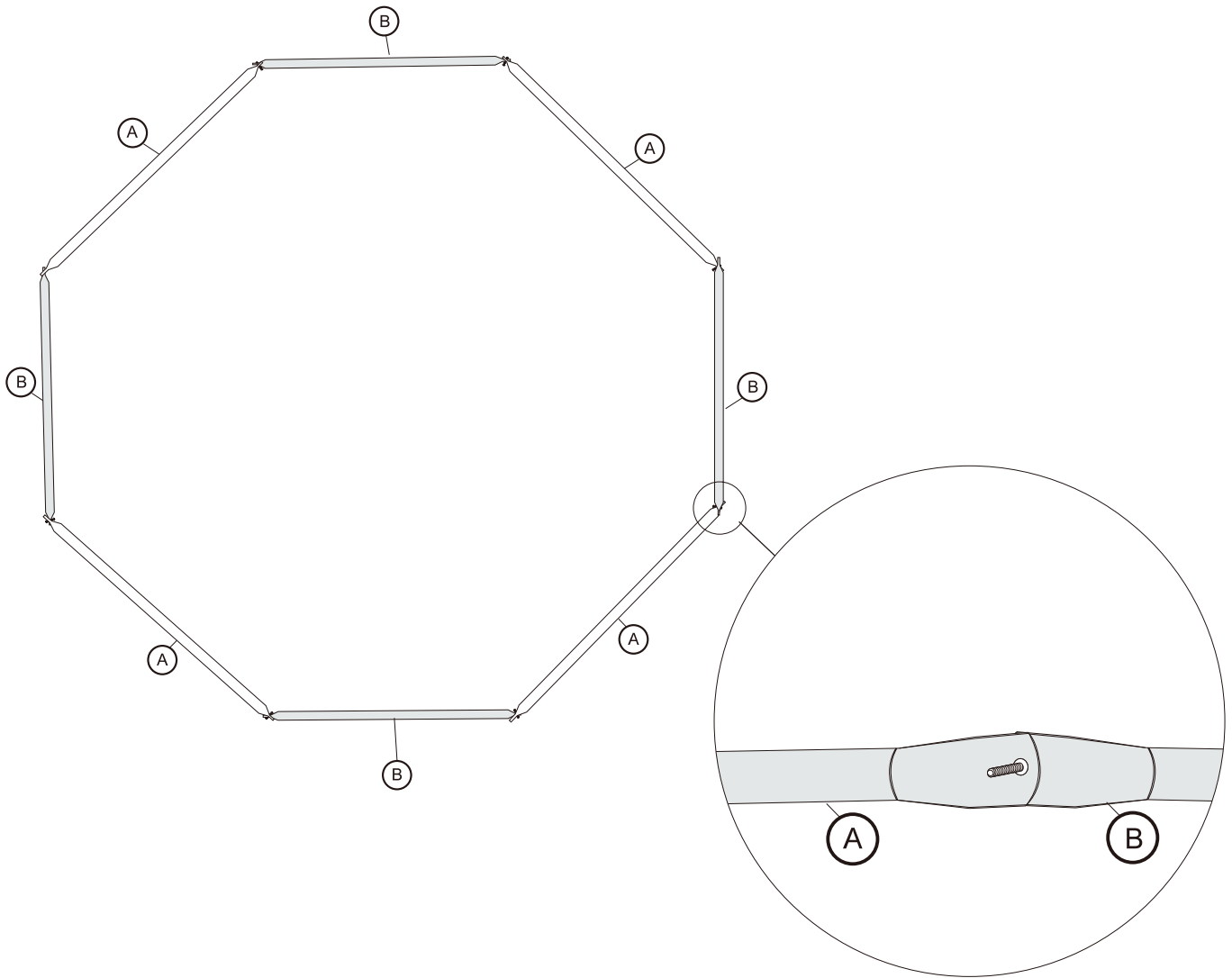

# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

Lay the round base using tubes A and B, and connect them together with bolts.

Do not fit nut at this stage.



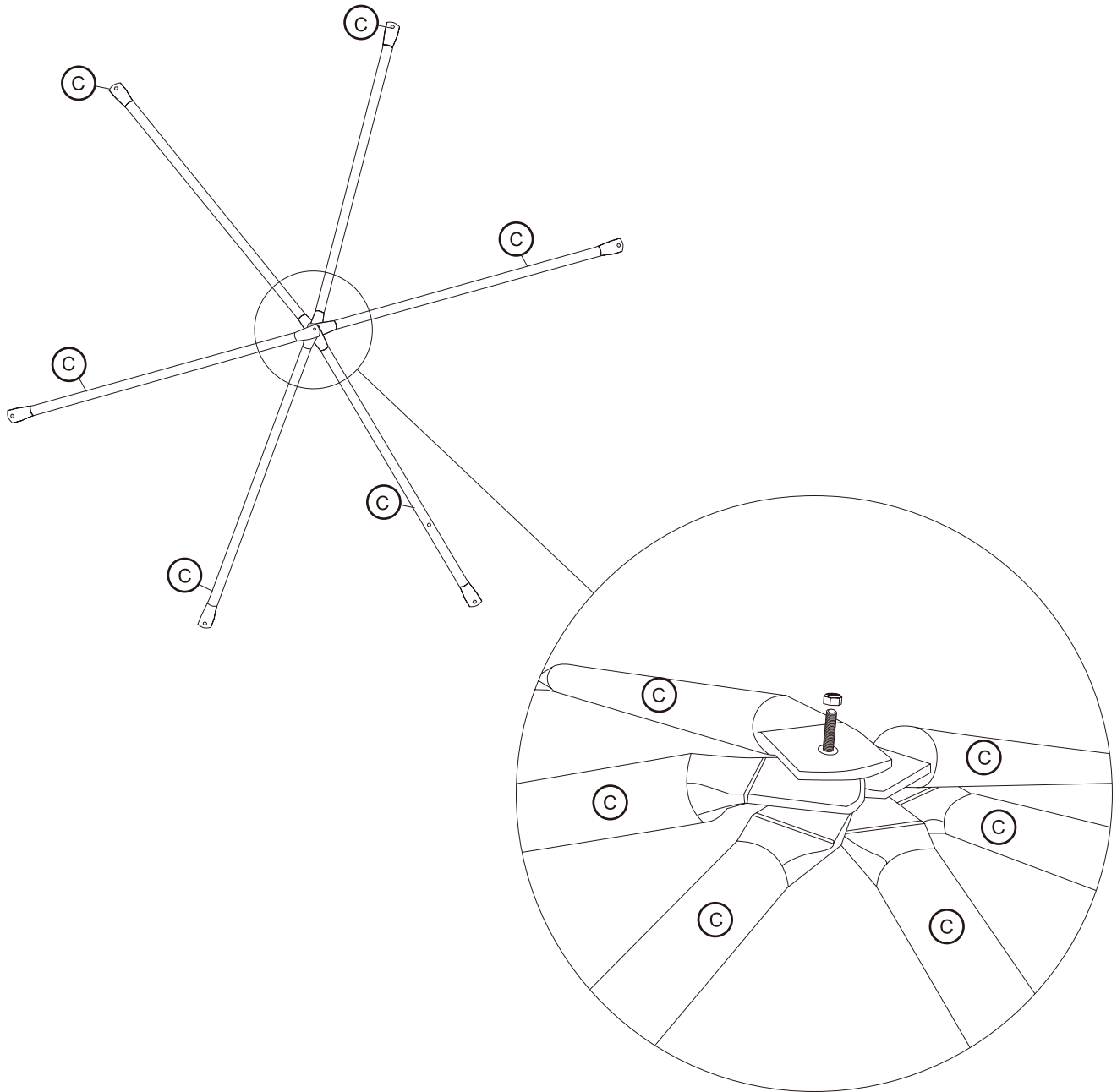
**NOTE:** The screws go through from the inside out. The convex side of the tube always faces inward of the dome.

**NOTE:** If you have any problems by this stage, please do not try to install the climbing dome and call our National Service Centre 1300 777 137.

# Assembly Instructions (cont)

## Step 2

Assemble as illustrated below. Use six pieces of Tube C to form a hexagon with one bolt and one flat nut. Repeat to form four hexagons.



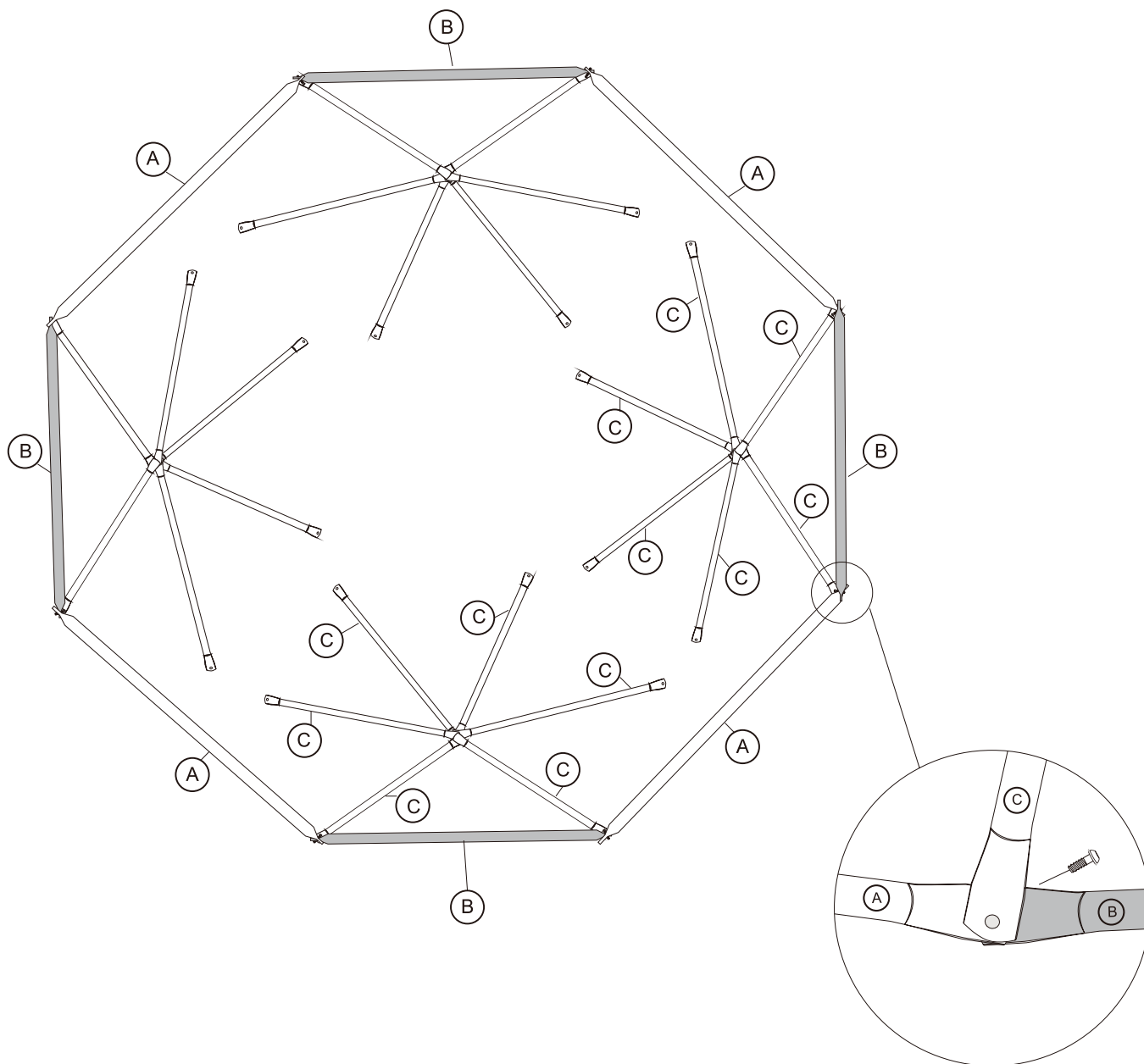
**NOTE:** The screws go through from the inside out. The convex side of the tube always faces inward of the dome.

# Assembly Instructions (cont)

## Step 3

Join two tube C from one hexagon to tube B on the base using bolt.

Do not fix with nut at this stage.

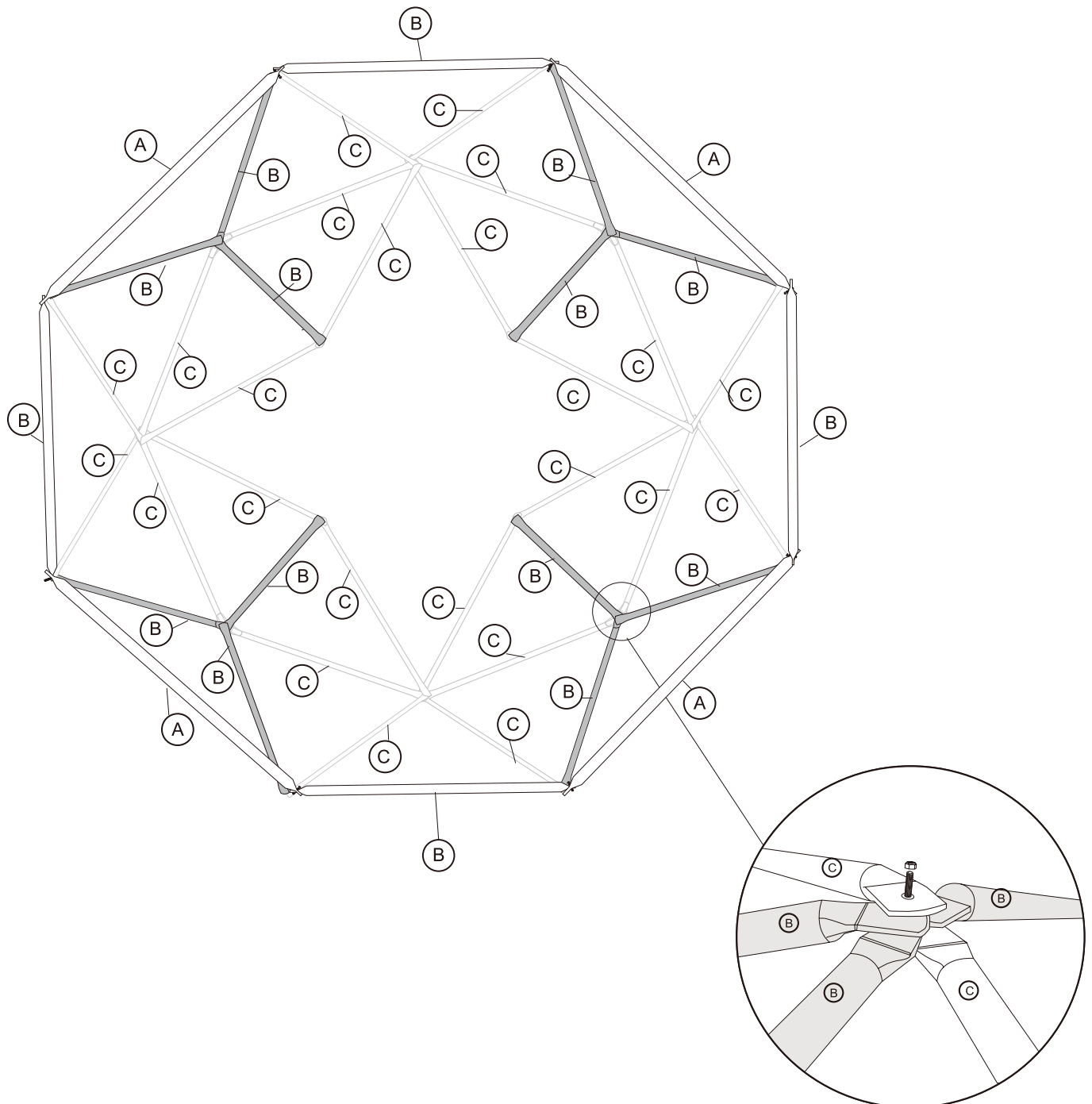


# Assembly Instructions (cont)

## Step 4

Join the hexagons together by adding two Tube B to Tube A on base, fix with nut. Connect a third Tube B using nut to lock in place.

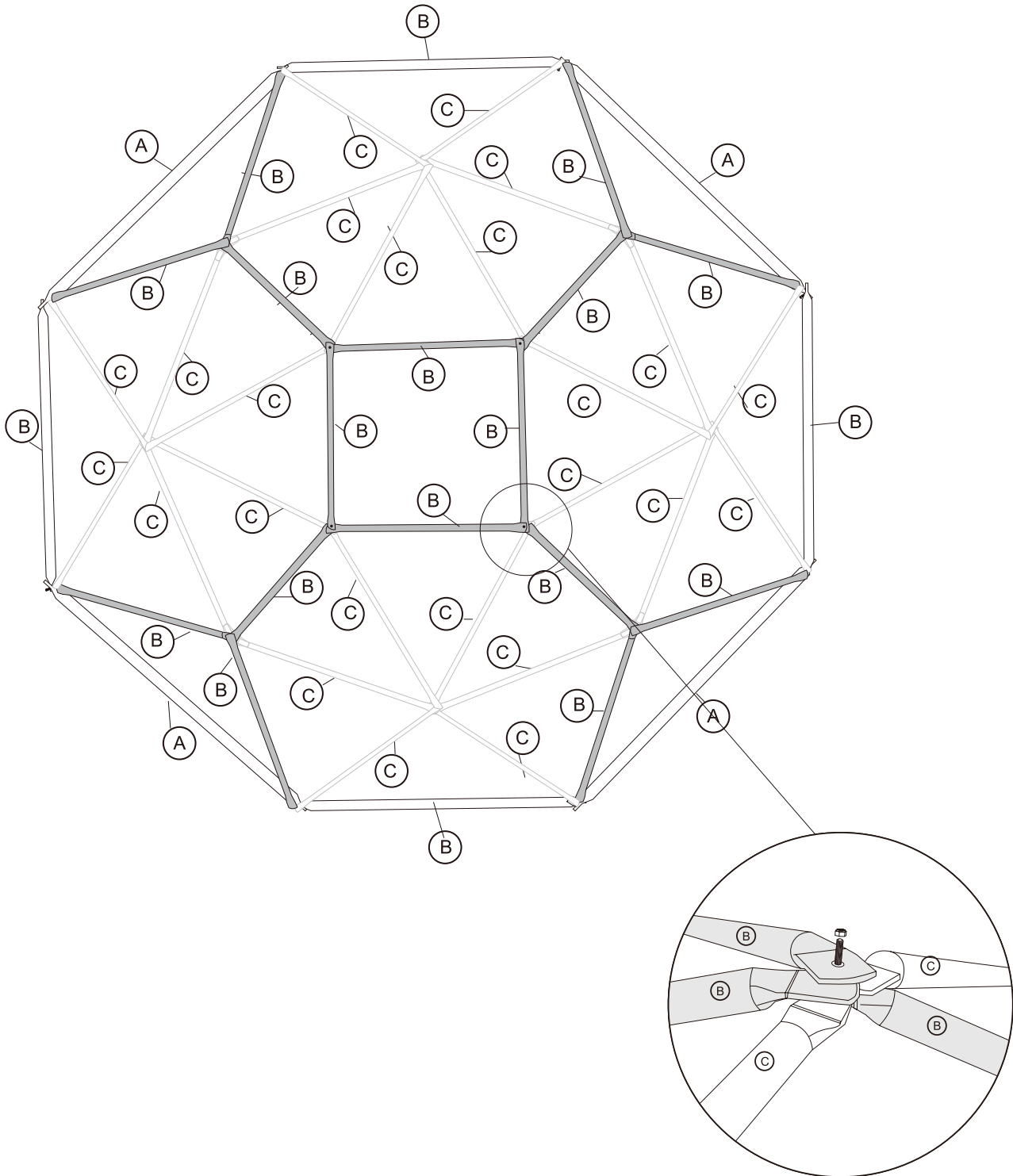
Now the base on the dome is completed.



# Assembly Instructions (cont)

## Step 5

Connect the top of the hexagons using final four Tube B, fixing in place with nut.

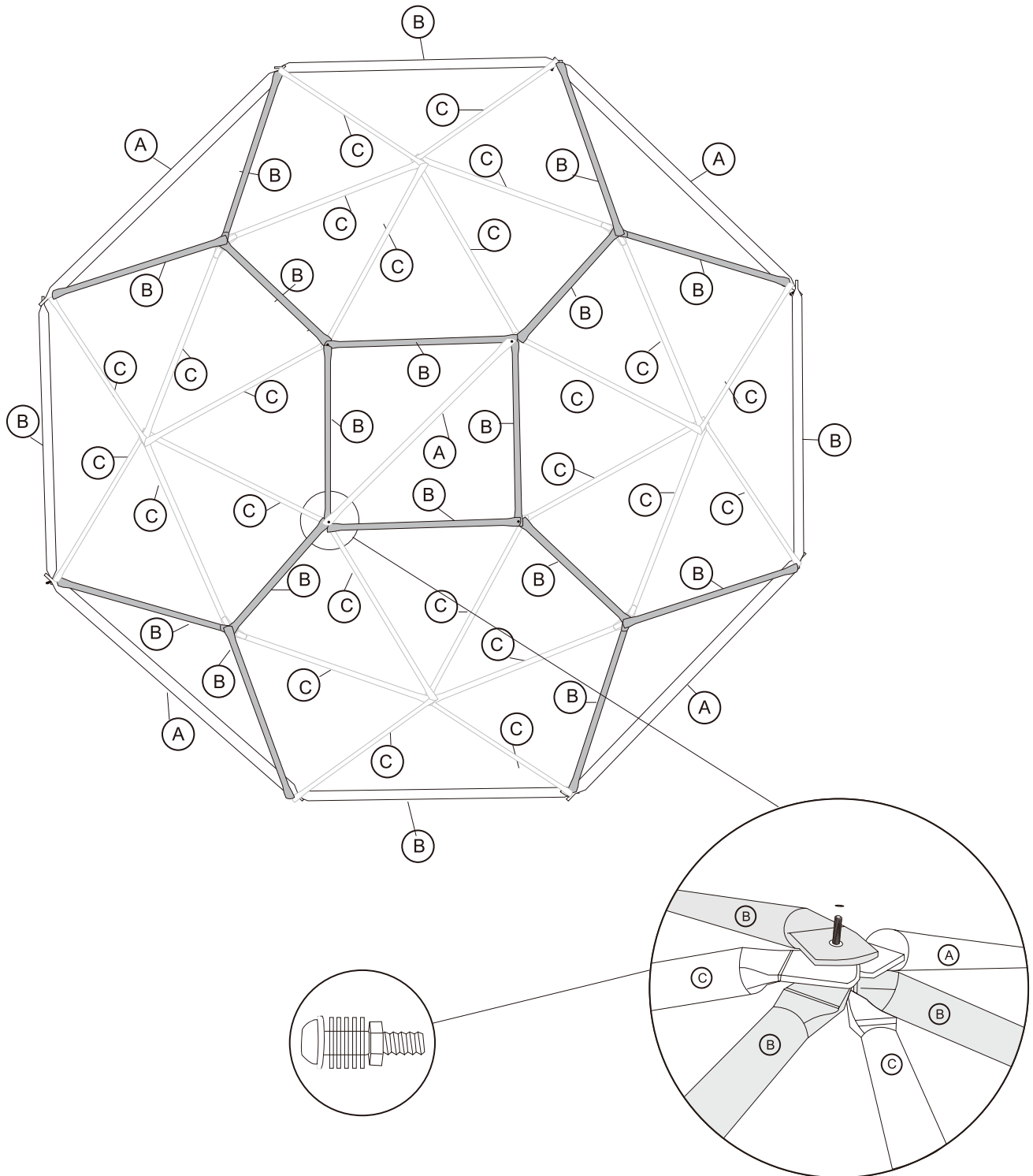


# Assembly Instructions (cont)

## Step 6

Join the final Tube A to the top square, replacing nut afterwards.

Please fully tighten all the bolts and nuts until snug.



# Assembly Instructions (cont)

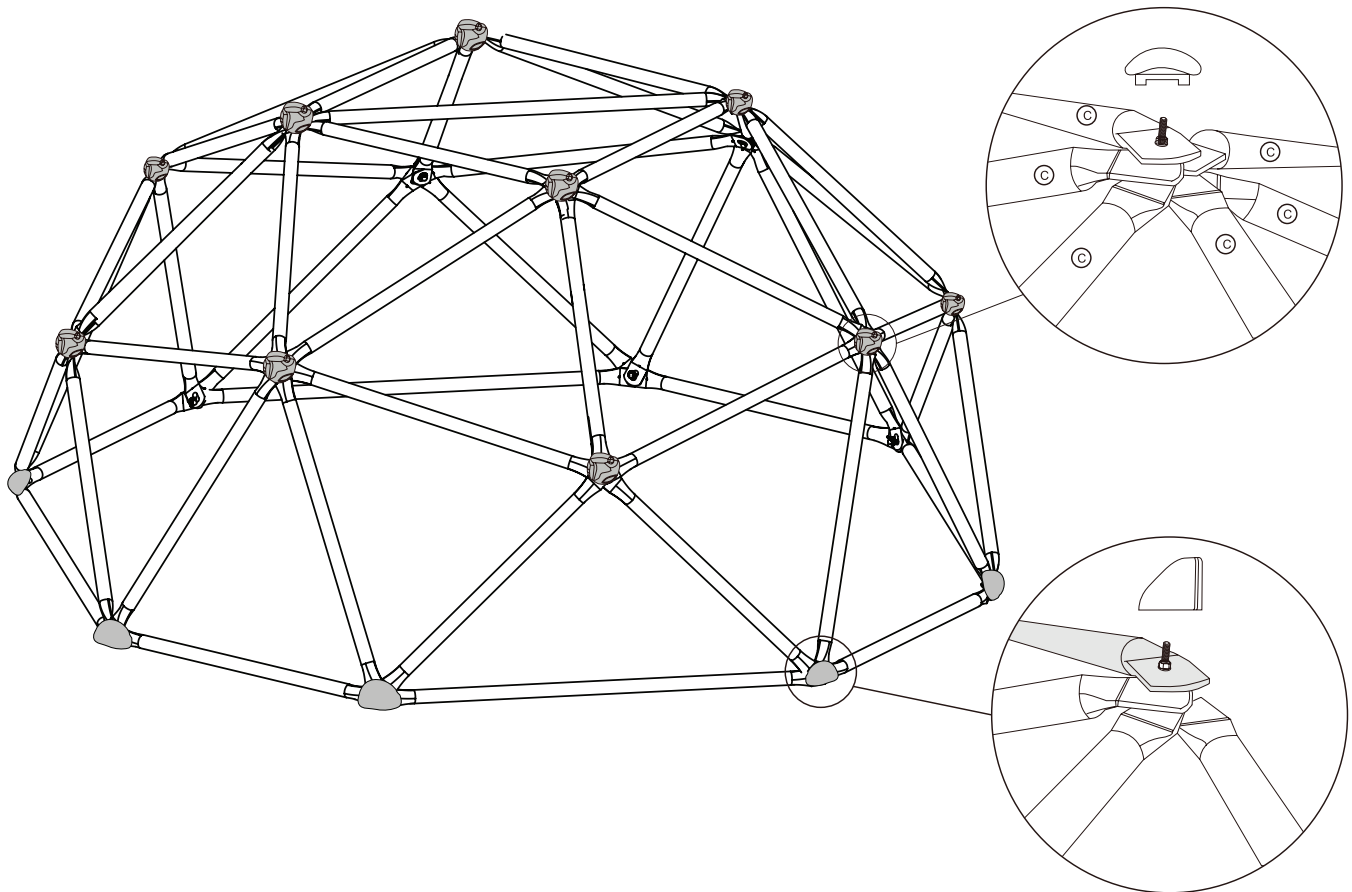
## Step 7

Cover the joins of the base with the small nodes x 8.

Cover the joins of remaining structure with large nodes x 12.

Use the allen key to tighten the nodes in place.

Ensure the notch of large node fits over the top of the tube join.

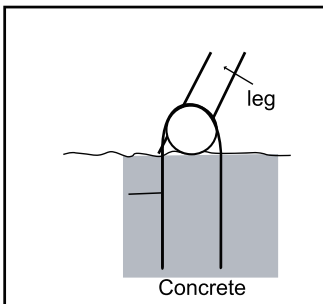
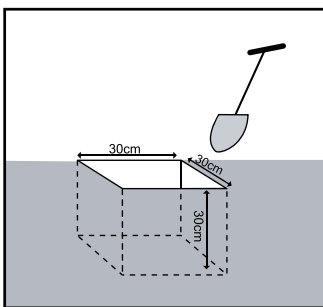


# Assembly Instructions (cont)

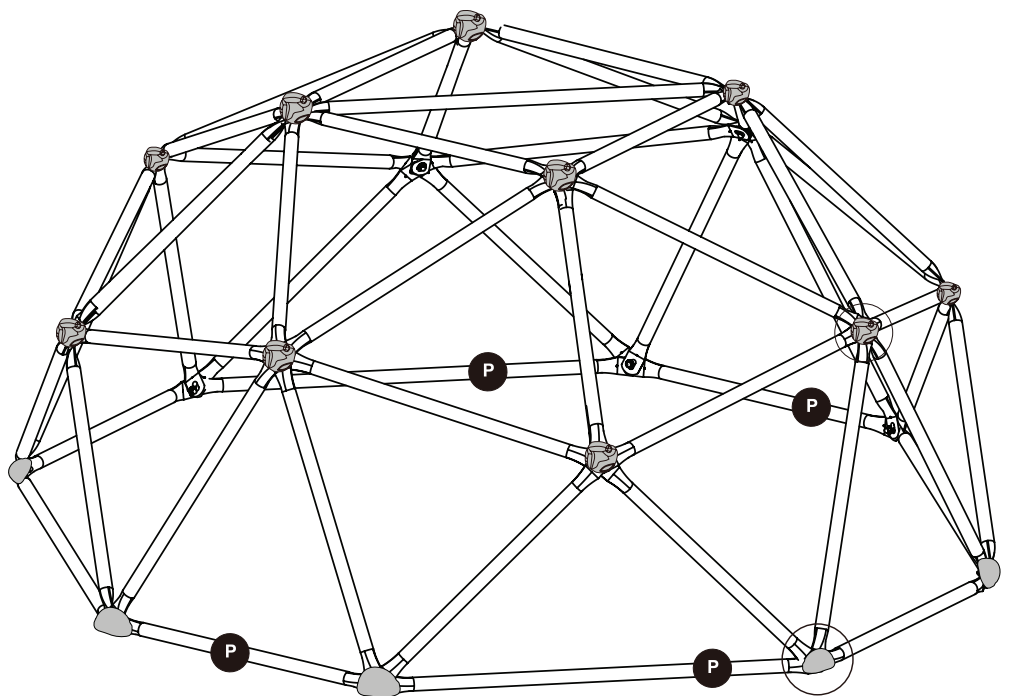
## Step 8

**WARNING:** For safety reasons this climbing wave **MUST** be anchored into the ground. To carry out this procedure you must hammer the included ground pegs into the ground at the angle shown in the picture above. The ground pegs must pull into hard earth and hold firmly. We highly recommend that the ground pegs be concreted but this is optional. However, if the ground is soft and the ground pegs can easily be pulled out by hand once installed then concreting is essential. Contact our Service Centre for more information if you are unsure regarding the installation of the ground pegs.

Anchors should be placed level with or under the ground in order to reduce tripping hazards.



**NOTE:** Dimensions recommended for concreting the pegs.

Once assembly is completed, carefully check equipment. In the unlikely event that you do find any problems, please contact us. DO NOT allow children to use this product until the problem has been corrected.

## Product Safety Checks And Maintenance

Carry out checks and maintenance of the main parts at regular intervals. If these checks are not carried out, the toy could overturn or otherwise become a hazard.

Check the sharp edges of all protective covers and bolts, and replace them if necessary.

Polish rusty areas and tubular parts and repaint them with lead-free paint if necessary.

This **Climbing Dome** is warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service conditions for a period of **12 months**, from the date of purchase of this article. Evidence of unfair usage or incorrect adjustment by the owner will void this promise.

## Making A Warranty Claim
